**Ballot Measure - Special Restaurant
and Hotel/Motel Tax for Freedom
Ridge Park Capital Improvements**

2024 Senate Bill 3221 authorized the City of Ridgeland, Mississippi, in the discretion of its elected officials to levy, assess and collect a special restaurant and hotel/motel tax for the purpose of providing funds for capital improvements for the enhancement of Freedom Ridge Park. Voting "for the tax" would authorize the governing authorities of Ridgeland to levy, assess, and collect a one percent (1%) tax on the gross proceeds of all sales from restaurants and a two percent (2%) tax on the gross proceeds of all sales from hotels and motels to provide funds solely for capital improvements for the enhancement of Freedom Ridge Park, Phase II and related purposes.
